

Impact of Pupil Premium Allocation on Learning 2105-16

Reception:

0 pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium.

Year 1:

5 pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium or Ever6FSM. All 5 pupils also on Special Educational Needs Register, including 1 pupil with an EHC Plan.

Reading - 60% pupils met the national expectation with 2 pupils (40%) exceeding this target.

Writing - 60% pupils met the national expectation with 1 pupil (20%) making accelerated progress, exceeding this target and their own End of Year target.

Maths - 60% pupils met the national expectation. 2 of these pupils (40%) made accelerated progress and exceeded their End of Year target of which 1 (20%) of these pupils exceeded the national expectation.

Year 2:

Cohort size - 2 pupils. This cohort contained 1 pupil on the Special Educational Needs register who was new to the school in January 2016.

Reading - 50% pupils achieved and exceeded the national expectation and exceeded their own End of Key Stage target.

Writing - 50% pupils achieved the national expectation.

Maths - 50% pupils achieved the national expectation.
