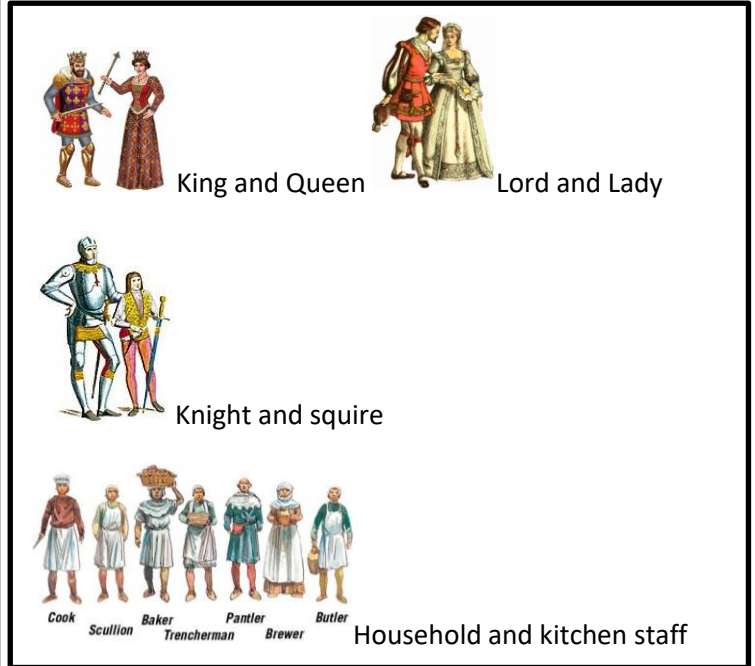
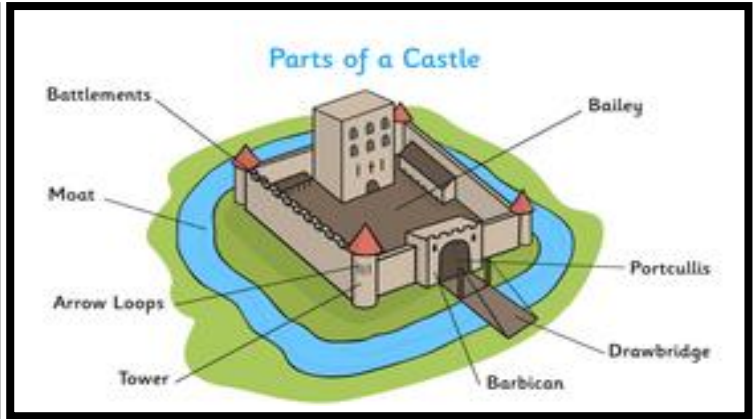


Historians say...

Fact	A thing that is known or proved to be true.
Fiction	Something that isn't true and is made up.
Opinion	A view or judgement formed about something, not necessarily based on fact or knowledge.
Sources of information	A place where information comes from (e.g. book, website, word of mouth).
Past	Something that has happened .
Present	Something that is happening now .
Future	Something that will happen.
Evidence	Facts that show whether something is true or false. (Proof)
Century	100 years.
Decade	10 years.
Chronology	Following the order in which events occurred.
Artefact	An object made by a human being, usually from the past.
Medieval	Relating to the Middle Ages.

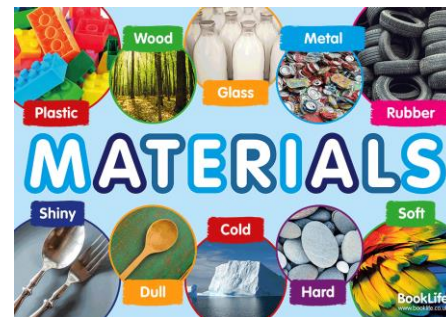

CLAY vocabulary

Here are some words that are helpful to know when you are making art with clay:

- SLAB**: A SLAB is a flat "pancake" of clay made with your hands or a rolling pin.
- COIL**: A COIL is a long, thin rope of clay made by rolling with your hands. Try to make it an even thickness.
- POT**: A POT is a piece of pottery.
- KILN**: The KILN is a special oven that gets super-hot. To fire clay into ceramic.
- SCORE**: Joining wet clay is done by SCORING, or roughly scratching and adding liquid clay - called SLIP. This seals the pieces together.
- SLIP**: SLIP is the word for fired clay.
- GLAZE**: POTTERY is a ceramic container, like a mug. GLAZE is painted on and fired until it's glassy.
