

PE Premium Funding Impact Report 2018-19

The government is currently providing additional funding to further develop Physical Education (PE) provision in all primary schools. Our school received £17,199 for 2018-19. This money can only be spent on sport and PE provision, but schools have the freedom to choose how to spend the funding within the following key indicators.

Key Indicator 1: The engagement of all pupils in regular moderate to vigorous activity - kick start healthy active lifestyles.

Key Indicator 2: The profile of PE and sport being raised throughout the school as a tool to whole school improvement.

Key Indicator 3: Increased knowledge confidence and skills of all staff in PE and Sport

Key Indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

Key Indicator 5: increased participation in competitive sport

Chandag Infant School has chosen to spend this funding on membership of the Wellsway School Sports Partnership (SSP), updating of outdoor activities equipment, continuation of Forest School provision to enhance outdoor learning alongside purchase of new PE equipment to enable the provision of high quality PE. Below is an overview of how the school has benefitted in these areas.

SSP

During the 2018-19 academic year Chandag Infant School benefitted greatly from being part of the Schools Sport Partnership which is based at Wellsway School. The PE Co-ordinator is Sarah Stone.

Over the past year the SSP has provided the following opportunities for Chandag Infant School:

Organisation of cluster meetings for Keynsham Primary Schools PE Co-ordinators. This enables links to be established between local schools, professional dialogue between PE subject leaders and ideas/dates to be organised for PE events.

In School Curriculum CPD and Targeted Development – Chandag Infant School was provided with a menu of support options to choose from at the start of the academic year. This allowed us to channel our support in the areas where it was most needed. We were provided with the following support:

- Our PE specialist has delivered high quality PE lessons across the school, enhancing sport provision for all pupils
- Class teachers have had the opportunity to observe and teach alongside the specialist, enabling them to further develop professionally to ensure a sustained improvement in our delivery of PE.
- Identification of gifted and talented (G and T) children in PE. After school sports club run for G and T children in Year 2.
- Dance club run for Years 1 and 2 in terms 3 and 4 enabling children to take part in B&NES Dance Umbrella event and Keynsham Music Festival.

- Organisation of Health Week activities for all year groups including Sports Day

Term 5 - Year 1 and 2 Dance Umbrella Club for performance at Keynsham Music Festival July 2019.

Health Week – June 2019 - activities for all children throughout the school week together with before school and after school activities for children and their parent/carers. This week included Sports Day.

WMAT Rounders Festival for Year 2 PE Club children – led by Cath Burston.

Forest School Outdoor Learning

Throughout the school year each class had 6 Forest School sessions of 1.5 hours led by a Level 3 Forest School leader based at Chandag Junior School's Forest School area.

Kids Yoga

In Terms 3 and 4 each class had 6 Kids Yoga sessions of 30 mins led by a qualified Yoga teacher
