For morning drop-offs (from 7.30am) and afternoon pick-ups (3.30 – 6.00pm), parents/carers use the ZCC green gate found down the main drive, to the right of Chandag Junior School building.

When the gate is shut, access is by using the ZCC bell, and intercom to a staff member in Classroom 9.



We use two detached buildings in the small Junior playground.

The cream building straight ahead (Kitchen and Music room) is where we have food and share a variety of activities before school. Card games are particularly popular for the Juniors after breakfast! Children can choose activities such as colouring, jigsaws, Jenga, Lego, Knex, Dominoes or other games.

There are two sets of toilets available and a generous tarmac playground. The Forest School area nearby is out of bounds during all sessions, but provides delightful surroundings.

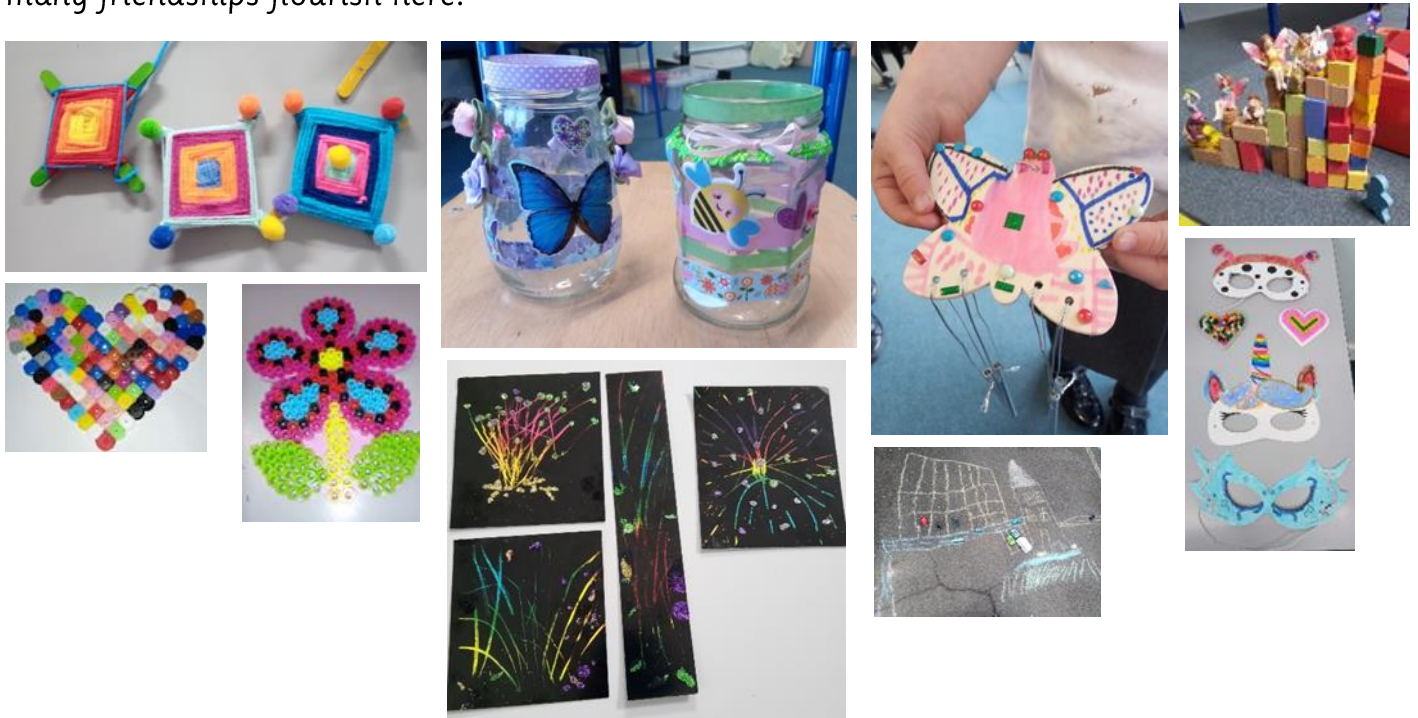
